

What is a Gospel Story?

It is your story of how you became a Christian and telling others about your personal journey. Answer the questions below to help you tell your Gospel Story!

1. What were you like before you met the Lord Jesus Christ?

Tips: What were you like? What were your struggles? What were you looking for in life? What made you feel good about yourself? What did you want from life?

2. When did you realize you were a sinner and could not get to Heaven on your own?

Tips: How did you first hear about Jesus? What was it like? Who told you? What made you want to know more about him? What did you feel? What did you think?

3. How did you ask the Lord Jesus Christ to forgive you of your sins?

Tips: How did you first hear about Jesus? What was it like? Who told you? What made you want to know more about him? What did you feel? What did you think?



4. How did your life change after you trusted the Lord Jesus Christ as your Saviour?

Tips: What's different now that you know Jesus? What changes have you noticed? How have you changed?

5. What is God doing in your life now?

Tips: What are some of the ways Jesus has helped you? What has been good? What makes you happy?



Once you have answered the questions, go back and review your answers. If someone read your answers, could they understand what your Gospel Story is, and could they see Lord Jesus Christ as the star of your Gospel Story?

6. Tell how others can receive the Lord Jesus Christ and have their own Gospel Story using the Gospel in Colors.

Yellow: God loves you and has a purpose and plan for your life – God loved you so much that he created you and made a specific plan for your life before you were born.

Black: All people are sinners – There is no sin allowed in Heaven; therefore, we can never get to Heaven on our own.

Red: Christ paid for our Sins – Jesus showed us his love for us when we were sinners and did not deserve it.

White: Forgiveness – If we personally ask for forgiveness, Jesus will forgive us of our sins. This is a choice that only you can make.

Green: Grow and Go – After we know the Lord Jesus Christ as our personal Saviour, He wants us to get to know him through listening and speaking to him. Jesus speaks to you through the Bible. We talk to Jesus through prayer. Have you listened to Jesus and talked to him today?
